

Elizabeth Dwight  
18 March 1790 - 6 July 1865

Elizabeth was born in Shirley, Middlesex, Massachusetts. She was the daughter of John Dwight and Susannah Gerry. Elizabeth's mother married Edward Kellogg 25 December 1792. Elizabeth married Samuel Mott 24 December 1807 in Orwell, Rutland, Vermont. Their first two children were born there. They moved to Bethany, New York about 1811 where the rest of her fourteen children were born. Six of Elizabeth's children did not reach adulthood. Of her surviving eight children, at least six joined the church.

Elizabeth was baptized 11 August 1844 while they still lived in Bethany. Elizabeth and Samuel made the trip to Utah in 1854 with an independent company. They settled in Payson. Elizabeth received her endowments in the Endowment House 14 October 1859. Elizabeth and Samuel were listed in Payson during the 1860 census. Living with them were two of their grandchildren and their son Daniel. Elizabeth lived just long enough to see the end of the Civil War. She died Palmyra, Utah.
