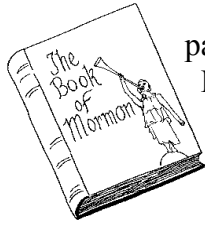


**Sarah Foreman**  
7 June 1764 - after May 1833



Sarah was from Fannette township in Franklin county, Pennsylvania. Her parents were Andrew and Mary Foreman. Her father was from Freehold, Monmouth, New Jersey, and she may have been born there as well. They lived in Franklin county, Pennsylvania at the times of the 1790 and 1800 census. They were living in Fannette, Franklin, Pennsylvania when she married Amos Moore.

The Moore family moved to Ohio and lived for a time in Clermont county. Her husband probably died before 1830 as he is not listed in the census. She was living with her son Andrew in Brown county, Ohio, when she joined the LDS church 1 May 1833. Both Brown and Clermont counties are just east of Cincinnati.

. . . Then came two other Elders, one by the name of Jonathan Sumner, and the other Simion Gardner. I went forward for baptism and was baptized about the first<sup>1</sup> of May 1833. My wife, eldest daughter, and Mother and two others were also baptized at the same time. They organized a branch there consisting of eleven members. Ordained one Elder and one Priest. We held meetings every Sabbath day.<sup>2</sup>

There is no mention or indication that Sarah went west to Missouri with her son Andrew and his wife. They did not go until the following year. Sarah may have died during that year. She was sixty-nine when she was baptized. Life expectancy was less than fifty years.
